SILVERTON PARISH NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN



As you may know, the Government introduced wide reaching changes to the planning system in the Localism Act 2011. In particular, the concept of Neighbourhood Plans has been adopted, whereby parish councils are empowered to draw up a plan for their parish, or parts of it, **in consultation with parishioners** for the future of the parish. Following the public meeting in St Mary's Church on the 25th February 2014 with the Forward Planning Officer from Mid Devon District Council, Silverton Parish Council decided on behalf of the parishioners that it should inform Mid Devon District Council of their intent to produce a Neighbourhood Plan for Silverton Parish. The preparation of a neighbourhood plan will enable everyone within the Parish to look at the various issues and identify possible solutions.

The process of preparing a Neighbourhood Plan is as follows:

- 1. Agreement in principle by the Parish Council to prepare a plan (Agreed at March meeting).
- 2. Confirm with Mid Devon District Council (done).
- 3. Public consultation on issues, proposals and opportunities (Booked for Friday 6th and Saturday 7th June in the Millenium Hall)
- 4. Preparation of first draft.
- 5. Second round of public consultation on draft plan (Planned for August)
- 6. Parish Council agrees final plan.
- 7. Examination of the plan by an independent assessor (September)
- 8. Referendum on the plan: to accept or reject it.

The first consultation dates are Friday 6th June from 6.00 - 8.00 pm in the Dorothy Grainger room of the Millenium Hall, and Saturday 7th June 9.30 am - 6.00 pm in the Millenium Hall itself.
