SILVERTON PARISH NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Minutes of the meeting held on Monday, May 23rd, 2016

Meeting began at 7.00 p.m.

4. The draft foreword for the Neighbourhood Plan was read and considered.

5. JR proposed that a new policy or policies should be included in the Plan concerned with back garden development and with site clearance and re-development. It was agreed that this should be referred to the Parish Council.

Housing policy H02 needs to be written up in more detail.

The Consultant advised that the results of the Housing Needs Survey, and any policy detail arising from them, should be discussed with MDDC. LG and JR will contact MDDC to arrange consultation.

6. Most of the material needed for the Draft Plan has now been submitted, although work is still needed on five policies. Design Statements should be considered and should be ready for the next Consultation. Designation of green spaces and recreation areas is still in progress. Some more photos are needed.

7. It was agreed that the next Consultation should take place in July and if possible should be split between the Lamb Inn Shed and the Dorothy Grainger Room. Proposed dates were Friday, July 8th (evening session 5.00 p.m. to 8.30 p.m.) and Saturday, July 9th (morning session 10 a.m. to 2.00 p.m.) or Friday July 15th and Saturday July 16th at the same times.

8. A.O.B. General comments on the Draft Plan will be considered at the next meeting. Information on Strategic Environmental Assessment from MDDC will be needed in relation to site allocation.

9. The next meeting will be on Tuesday, June 7th, at 7.00 p.m.

10. Site allocation reports were discussed.

11. Potential future recreation spaces were considered.
