- 2. Up-date on Terms of Reference 3.8: These were accepted at an extraordinary meeting of Silverton Parish Council with the exception of 3.8. Jenny was now able to clarify that it will be in order for us draw our money as necessary without having to go through a Parish Council Meeting.
- 3. Discussion re Budget: It was agreed that we purchase a printer, inks, paper etc. so that we can print our Plan ourselves. We will however approach a printer to do the cover page. - 6. Date for next consultation: It was decided it was premature to set one yet.
- 7. Any other business: Liz T. suggested we have a Heritage Trail round the village, she & Bill will look for further information. Heritage, Environment & listed buildings are things of interest of interest.
