


May 2024 – Events and Services at St. Matthew's Coldridge

Thursday 9th May Ascension Day – 7pm, Zeal Monachorum

The whole Mission Community is invited to celebrate Ascension Day at the Church of St Peter the Apostle in Zeal Monachorum.

This beautiful Devon church dates from the 12th century. It purple-basalt Norman font was reinstated in 1853 after being found in the graveyard!

On this day we commemorate the miraculous event, forty days after Easter, when the risen Christ appeared before the grieving apostles and told them to remain in Jerusalem and await the coming of the Holy Spirit.

After he had spoken, Christ was swept up in cloud and taken to Heaven.

The observance of this Feast of Ascension is of great antiquity, and dates from at least the 4th century.

On this day, also called Pentecost or Whitsunday, we commemorate the moment when the Holy Spirit first came to the apostles.

After gathering in Jerusalem for nine days of continuous prayer, the apostles heard a sound like roaring wind, saw flames of fire around their heads and miraculously gained the power to preach Christ's message in many languages. The Holy Spirit is one of the most mysterious and debated elements in Christian theology.
